CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

These are the terms and conditions upon which the Glasshouse Christian College Dance Academy ('The Academy'), an organised activity of Glasshouse Christian College, provides extra-curricular Dance Services ('Services'). The Academy does not have a separate legal identity from the College.

In these terms and conditions the terms 'You' and 'Your' means the Parent(s) or Guardian(s) of the Student. Where the words 'We', 'our' and 'Us' appears that is a reference to the Academy.

This is an Agreement between the Student's Parent(s) or Guardian(s) and the Academy.

- The Academy provides the following Services:

Dance Instruction for students of GCC in the following genres:

Classical Ballet

Jazz

Contemporary

Hip Hop

Tap

1. Enrolment is on a term-by-term basis
2. Students in receipt of Fee Relief and Families in arrears on their School Fees will not be permitted to participate in the programs run by the Dance Academy. This is in recognition of the importance that the College places on the payment of School Fees and the priority with which it expects parents of the College to pay said fees. In recognition of the short notice of this condition, this clause will be waived for 2018 only. For further information, please refer to the Terms and Conditions of your enrolment contract.
3. Invoices for each term will be issued one week prior to commencement of term and are payable in full prior to the end of the first week of each term. The term dates for the Academy are the same as the Term Dates of Glasshouse Christian College.
4. All payments are to be made through the designated system. The College will not accept payments through the administration office.
5. Unpaid invoices by this date will negate enrolment in the class and the position offered to a waitlisted student.

6. Classes will require a minimum of four (4) students to run and will be capped. The maximum number of participants in each class will vary depending on the style of Dance. Waitlists will be created should spaces become available.
7. Individual students will not have missed lessons made up or refunded other than for lesson cancellations due to Public Holidays or teacher absences. Classes on Anzac Day (Weds 25/4/18) and Labour Day (Mon 7/5/18) Public Holidays will be moved to the Friday of that week.
8. Students intending to discontinue lessons are required to inform the College in writing prior to the end of the current term. Students who discontinue lessons after the commencement of the term will not be reimbursed for that term's fees.
9. Students are required to supply and wear the specific uniform requirements as listed per class.
10. The Cancellation of Enrolment by Parent/Guardian. The Parent of the participating student may cancel their enrolment by written notice at any time. The cancellation will take effect on the last day of the term in which the student is currently enrolled or at the end of the term in which date of cancellation has been notified.
11. Cancellation of Enrolment by the Academy. The enrolment of a student in the academy will be cancelled where any of the following occurs:
 - a. if You fail to comply with any reasonable direction issued by any staff member of the Academy which compromises our ability to provide our Services to Students or compromises the safety and welfare of others Students of the Academy;
 - b. for any other reason outside our control which has the effect of compromising our ability to perform the Services within the required timeframe;
 - c. If any of the conditions in this agreement are not met; and
 - d. if, in its sole discretion, the Academy considers it is no longer appropriate to provide the Services to You.
12. Fitness to Participate. The Academy provides the Services on the assumption that the Student is fit to participate in the Dance Classes. By accepting this Agreement, the Student agrees the Student is fit to participate in the Dance Classes.
13. Dance Class Hygiene No food is permitted in the Dance Studio. Students are required to bring water or other refreshments to hydrate themselves during Dance Class.
14. Student Conduct During Dance Class. The Academy is committed to providing an enjoyable experience for all Students. The Academy will not tolerate the following forms of unacceptable behaviour:
 - a. verbal or physical abuse;

- b. intimidation by a Student or another Student or intimidation by a Parent or Guardian of any Student (including the Student that is child of the Parent of Guardian);
- c. harassment or threats of any nature towards Student, Parents and Guardians, or any employees or contractors or third parties attending the Academy.

The behaviours described in clause above, extends to those behaviours occurring at any location attended by the Academy and during any performances (including before the commencement of any performance and after any performance) made by Students of the Academy.

15. Prohibition on Photograph and Video Recordings Due to our privacy obligations under State and Commonwealth legislation no photograph and video recordings shall be permitted of any classes or Student performances wherever they may occur, unless express approval has been given.
